

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-071

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CITRUS HEIGHTS,
OPPOSING THE “CONTROL, REGULATE AND TAX ADULT USE OF MARIJUANA
ACT” OR “THE ADULT USE OF MARIJUANA ACT” INITIATIVE**

WHEREAS, The Control, Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act, commonly known as the Adult Use of Marijuana Act (“Initiative”) has qualified for the November 2016 statewide ballot as Proposition 64; and

WHEREAS, under the Initiative, individuals age 21 or older could legally possess, use gift, transport, process, and cultivate marijuana under state law with limited restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the Initiative prevents local jurisdictions from prohibiting the transportation or delivery of marijuana or marijuana products on public roads by a business licensee acting in compliance with the Initiative and local law; and

WHEREAS, the Initiative requires local governments to implement, regulate, and enforce its provisions at a local level without identifying a viable funding source; and

WHEREAS, the potential revenue and expenditure impacts of this Initiative are subject to considerable uncertainty; and

WHEREAS, the Initiative poses significant public safety and quality of life concerns to the Citrus Heights community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City of Citrus Heights does hereby join the California Police Chiefs Association, California District Attorneys Association, and California Narcotic Officers’ Association in opposing the Initiative.

The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


