RE: Liquidambar tree located in the side yard

Dear Mr. Bartlett

As requested I inspected the above referenced tree. The following are my findings and recommendation:

Liquidambar

Diameter	: 19 inches
Dripline Radius	: 15 feet
Trunk flare	: Poor – girdling roots
Trunk	: Poor – co-dominant @ 12", included bark
Primary Limbs	: Poor – topped @ 20', re-growth poorly attached
Foliage	: Poor – 25% dead
Dripline Environment	: Grass, foundation
Overall Tree Rating	: Poor
Recommendations	: Remove tree – see paragraph below

This tree is in declining health. There are multiple co-dominant attachments, the roots have been damaged by lawn mowers and show signs of major decay, and drought damage is also evident. I recommend this tree be removed due to the overall poor condition.
