## What is a Neighborhood Champion?

The City of Citrus Heights has initiated a community-based process to improve multi modal safety in the City's neighborhoods. The program includes improving the way residents can request traffic control and traffic calming devices in their neighborhoods and promotes efforts by citizens to raise safety awareness.
