Metal

Aerosol cans (empty)
Aluminum cans
Aluminum foil (clean)
Aluminum pie plates
Cookie sheets
Food cans (clean)
Paint cans, latex (empty and dried)
Pet food cans
Steel cans
Tin cans

Glass

Empty; all colors; lids and caps OK
Bottles
Jars

Plastic

Containers only; empty with chasing arrows #1-#7; lids and caps OK
Baby wipe containers
Bleach bottles
Buckets without metal handles
Containers for soda, water, juice
Detergent bottles
Household cleaning containers, empty
Lids and caps
Milk jugs

Plant containers (plastic, chasing arrows #1-#7)
Plastic bags (**Place in one large bag and close.**)
Prescription bottles (empty)
Salad dressing bottles
Shampoo and conditioner bottles
Tub containers (yogurt, cottage cheese, margarine, chasing arrows #1-#7)
Water jugs

REMINDERS

- Collections are **BIWEEKLY** (every other week) on the same day as your garbage service.
- Place all recyclables in the blue recycling cart.
- Be sure materials fit inside cart with lid closed.
- Cardboard that won't fit in the cart may be placed next to the recycling cart. Please break down and tie in a bundle.
- No garbage or green waste materials.
- No metal pipe or plumbing fixtures.
- No hazardous waste.
- Before discarding, consider reusing or donating.

Place carts out by 5:30 a.m. or the night before, and keep carts 3 feet apart.
