



Calvary Cemetery Maintenance Facility – Description of Activities

The proposed Calvary Cemetery Maintenance Facility will have the same activities within it as the former facility which was located on the new funeral center site and the same activities that are currently occurring on the proposed site through the use of temporary facilities.

The proposed facility will include office, breakroom and meeting space for the Cemetery Grounds staff consisting of the Cemetery Manager, the Cemetery Foreman and 3 – 8 Cemetery Groundsmen. Restrooms, uniform lockers and safety shower facilities will be included.

The facility will be used for the storage of equipment such as mowers, utility vehicles, trimmers, blowers, edgers and miscellaneous hand tools. There will be storage areas for irrigation supplies and equipment as well as interment supplies.

There will be a mechanics bay used for the storage of tools and the repair and maintenance of on-site equipment.

Additionally, this facility will include an area for the receiving and inventorying of memorials from vendors as well as for the ability to clean, repair and restore memorials.

Soil, rock and other landscape materials will be stored outside in constructed containment bays. An equipment wash area will be used for the daily cleaning of equipment. Backhoes, dump trucks, interment vaults and dumpsters will continue to be stored outside.

A separate garage will be for the storage of Funeral Coaches and Flower Vans. This will be a new activity for the area but one that should not pose any impact on the neighborhood.

General activity within the maintenance yard will occur between the hours of 7:00am and 3:30pm, Monday through Saturday.

These activities are currently occurring on the proposed site via the use of a temporary office trailer, temporary storage containers and temporary fencing. These activities have been occurring for approximately a year without complaint from the neighboring homes or community association.
