



2013 Auburn Boulevard Complete Streets Revitalization Project Project Updates

12-12-13 Update: The weekly Coffee Meet-Ups on **December 18th, December 25th and January 1st** have been cancelled. We hope everyone enjoys the holidays and has a happy new year. The next Coffee Meet-Up will be **January 8th at 9:30 a.m.** at Rusch Park (7801 Auburn Boulevard).

11-21-13 Update: The weekly Coffee Meet-Up for November 27th has been **cancelled**. We hope everyone enjoys the Thanksgiving holiday.

11-7-13 Update: Storm drain and water work continues from Sylvan Corners to Pratt Ave. Roadway excavation from Sylvan Trailer to Willow Way (east-side) is expected to start the week of November 18th.

10-30-13 Update: Work on Segment III has begun. New storm drain is being installed southbound and northbound. Lane closures are in affect northbound and southbound from Sylvan Corners to Cook Avenue.

10-16-13 Update: Segment III, street improvements from Sycamore Drive to Sylvan Corners, received its Notice to Proceed on October 14th. Work will be visible starting the week of October 21st.

9-25-13 Update: Segment II is nearing completion. In the coming weeks, the contractor will be installing the monument walls at the Auburn and Antelope intersection, placing the Rusch Park archway, finalizing landscaping, and small remaining items.

Stay tuned for the start of Segment III, street improvements from Sycamore Drive to Sylvan Corners.

8-21-13 Update: Night work is scheduled for August 26th and 27th. The contractor will be paving from Rusch Park to Sycamore Drive/Pratt Ave. The intersection of Auburn and Antelope Road will be on flash starting at 8:00 p.m. and one lane will be open in each direction.

7-31-13 Update: The Auburn Boulevard entrance to Rusch Park (7801 Auburn Boulevard) will be closed August 5-6th for construction. Patrons will be able to access Rusch Park through the back entrance on Oak Forest Street. Detour signs will be visible.

7-10-13 Update: Removal of the existing utility poles began this week. Most poles from Pratt to Rusch Park have been removed. Removal of all poles is expected by September 2013. The removal of the poles has allowed the remaining street improvements to move forward. On July 16, 2013 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. the traffic signal at Auburn and Antelope Road will be on flashing red in order to activate the new traffic signal system. Flaggers will be available to mitigate traffic back-up.

7-2-13 Update: The weekly Coffee Meet-up on July 3, 2013 has been **cancelled**. Weekly meetings will resume on July 10th. If you have any questions please contact the City's General Services Department at (916) 727-4770 or ABCteam@citrusheights.net.

6-12-13 Update: Night work at the intersection of Auburn Boulevard and Antelope Road is scheduled for **Thursday, June 13th** starting at **8:00p.m.** The signal will be on flash and one lane will be open in each direction. 5-22-13 Update: Driveways, sidewalks, and curb and gutter are being completed on the east-side of Auburn Boulevard. Grading on the west-side of Auburn Boulevard for driveways and sidewalks are taking shape from Rusch Park to Antelope Road. Switch overs from overhead to underground service are continuing timely. It is estimated that utility poles will come down in early July.

5-3-13 Update: New driveways, sidewalks and curb and gutter are starting to take shape on the east-side of Auburn Boulevard from Sycamore to Cripple Creek. Demolition has also started on the west-side of Auburn Boulevard with sidewalks scheduled to be constructed starting the week of May 13th.

4-25-13 Update: SMUD will be installing the last of three new 69 KVA poles on Auburn Boulevard between Watson Way and Antelope Road on **Thursday, May 2nd**. This work will occur during the day. 4-11-13 Update: This is a reminder to please obey the 25 MPH speed limit on Auburn Boulevard between Sylvan Corners and Rusch Park. In addition, sidewalk and curb and gutter improvements are starting to take shape from Antelope Road to Rusch Park.

3-20-13 Update: Utility companies have started to arrive on site to pull wires and switch properties over to underground service. Roadway excavation, sidewalk, and curb and gutter work has started on the east-side between Pratt and Antelope.

3-13-13 Update: SMUD will be installing a new 69 KVA pole at the corner of Watson Way and Auburn Boulevard on Tuesday, March 19th. Northbound traffic will be diverted to the southbound #1 lane.

2-22-13 Update: Joint Trench work continues between Carleton Lane and Sylvan Corners. Miscellaneous storm drain work is occurring at Watson Way. Lane closures are in effect when necessary. side. Stormdrain improvements are being installed between Rusch Park and Sycamore Drive. Finally, night work at the intersection of Auburn Boulevard and Antelope Road will occur January 28th - 31st.
