Does the ordinance requirements cost money for my business or multi-family complex?

Most businesses and multi-family complexes can save money by reducing trash collection service by implementing a comprehensive recycling program. Feel free to contact your waste hauler to learn more about reducing overall costs.

What about the new Mandatory Organics Recycling law ?

Some California businesses and multifamily properties are now required to start recycling their organic waste. Organic waste includes food waste, food-soiled paper waste, and landscaping waste (grass clippings, tree trimmings, etc.).

The new state law requires many Citrus Heights businesses & multifamily complexes to recycle organics based upon the following timetable:

- January 1, 2017—Generators of 4 or more cubic yards of organic waste per week
- January 1, 2019—Generators of 4 or more cubic yards of solid waste per week
- January 1, 2020—Generators of 2 or more cubic yards of solid waste per week, *if statewide disposal of organic waste is not decreased by half.*

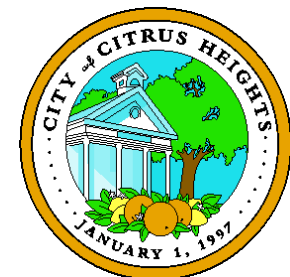

Why does the City adopt the Business and Multi-Family Recycling Ordinance?

First, Assembly Bill 341 (AB 341) requires businesses and public entities subscribing to 4 or more cubic yards of waste collection service per week and multi-family complexes with 5 or more units, regardless of waste collection service level, to implement an on-site recycling program. AB 341 sets a new statewide goal of 75% diversion of waste from our landfills.

Second, the City is committed to implementing cost-effective and efficient programs that contribute to environmental protection, green-house gas reduction, and energy independence. The Ordinance is intended to support to these efforts.

The City's ordinance is consistent with the new state commercial recycling law which took effect July 1, 2012.

Which Businesses and Multi-Family Properties must comply with the Ordinance?

The Ordinance requires owners and/or operators of businesses and multi-family complexes (with 5 or more units) that subscribe to four cubic yards per week or more of garbage collection service to implement an on-site recycling program.



What are the program requirements?

- 1. Complete a recycling plan.** You will be contacted by your trash hauler to complete a Recycling Plan if your business or multi-family property is subject to the Ordinance and AB 341. The Recycling Plan includes summary information about your business and indicates how you will comply with the Ordinance and AB 341.
- 2. Separate "recyclables" from trash.** Recyclables include mixed paper, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, cardboard, plastic containers (#1-7), glass containers, and aluminum and tin cans.
- 3. Provide for the collection and delivery of recyclables to a recycling facility by either:**
 - a. Entering into a Service Agreement with a franchised hauler or authorized recycler for the collection of recyclables; OR
 - b. Self-hauling recyclables to an appropriate facility. For this option you must complete and retain on-site a Self-Haul Certification Form.
- 4. Provide containers to collect recyclable materials in businesses and multi-family complexes.**
- 5. Post and maintain signs in areas where recyclables are collected.**
- 6. Educate employees and tenants about the program.**
